We are now providing a FREE after school activities to enrich your child's life experience and knowledge. During the after school activity we will be providing one of the following: a group activity; a guest speaker or a field trip that aims to expose and teach something new and educational.

The after school activity will occur on the second and/or last Monday of each month. A flyer will be sent home each month, at least two weeks prior to the event, to inform the student and the parents of the activity topic and time frame. Each activity will provide drinks and snacks. The students will be picked up from their school and brought to Deaf Services Center (located at 5830 North High Street, Worthington, Ohio) or parents can choose to bring their child to DSC. After the activity students will either be transported home by DSC or be picked up by a parent/guardian from DSC.

If your child desires to attend the after school activities please fill out the contact permission and emergency information form that is attached. This form will only need to be completed and signed once a year. However each event flyer will have a cut out permission slip required only if a parent/guardian gives permission for their child to attend and be transported by DSC. The forms should be brought to school and given to the student's teacher. Again there is no cost for your child to participate in the after school activities.

Common Questions & Answers:

Who are the staffs that will be with my child/children?

The staff that will be with your children will be Karen Parker, the DKTC coordinator, Kassandra Schrienk, the Resource Director and Sami Staton, the transportation driver.

Who will be driving the kids, which vehicle will be used?

The staff listed above will be driving, they all have passed their background check, insurance and drivers' licenses are all valid.

If I sign the permission and emergency contact form, does this mean my child has to attend each activity?

No, you only have to complete the permission and emergency form once. Your child is not required to attend each activity but if he/she wants to attend the activity, the permission slip will need to be filled out, signed and brought with the child the day of the activity.

What if my child forgets the permission slip?

If your child somehow forgot the permission slip, we would be giving the parents a call to double check if the child is indeed allowed to attend the activity, if not the child will be going home after school.

What if I plan to pick up but can't, are you able to bring my child home?
